The Agnese Nelms Haury Program (the Haury Program) is a University of Arizona-embedded philanthropic program established in 2014 with what was at that time the largest bequest ever received by the University. The Haury Program is governed by an external Donor Advised Fund Board. Since 2020, the Haury Program has been focusing on advancing Indigenous resilience, especially environmental resilience and water work, by investing in Indigenous resilience research, education and outreach, supporting academic pathways, and fostering community collaborations and partnerships. The Haury Program seeks to model best practices in “trust-based” and “university-embedded” philanthropy, to share its experiences with other philanthropic partners, and to lead efforts to inspire others to join them in this work.
